## Why Advocate?

Your voice has the power to:

- Influence policy decisions
- Improve community services
- Ensure the needs of older people are met
- Educate people about an issue

## What Needs to Change?

Think about what issues or policies impact:

- The local community
- · Groups you identify with
- Organizations
- Larger systems

### **Plan A Message**

- Tell a story
- · Keep it clear
- · State the issue
- Propose a credible solution
- Practice!

### **Choose An Advocacy Method**

- Contact Elected Officials Write letters, send emails or make phone calls.
- Attend Public Meetings Speak during public comment periods at town halls or council meetings.
- Join or Start a Group Collaborate with others who share similar concerns to amplify the message.
- Share Your Story Talk to friends, family and community members to raise awareness.
- Write a Letter to the Editor



# **Important Tips**

## Be Respectful

Always maintain a polite tone, even when disagreeing.

#### Be Patient + Persistent

Change takes time. Don't get discouraged by setbacks.

#### Be Informed

Always back up your claims with accurate information.

#### Celebrate Wins

Thank the legislators who engaged with even if you didn't get everything that you wanted.
